Points raised: -

1. Proposed gravel path on B3212 – The CCTV has been carried out on the present pathway.
Details from Ines – The piping that has been used for the drainage section already installed is 400 plastic twin wall pipe and this will need to be continued. Drains will also need to be installed with a drainage channel and basin going into the pipe at intervals. We need to wait to hear from the Environment Agency to confirm whether anything else is needed. The Council then needs to do a complete drawing showing the above details and DCC and the Environment Agency need to approve. A traffic plan is also needed (apply for a 171 license) To do this, use Google maps and put a picture of traffic lights where they will be needed on either end of the work area. **Action Ines/Clerk**
2. Farrant's Hill works still due in August.
3. Grit bins – This is still being processed. We hope it will be complete before the Autumn!

4. Spraying training – We need to ask Teignbridge for advice on this, not Devon. **Action Clerk**
