

Meeting of Clerk with Ines Scillitoe, Highways Devon County Council

Points raised: -

1. Proposed gravel path on B3212 – The questions from DCI (Danny) were put to Ines. 1. It will need to be organised that all utilities do a stats survey and recommend what is needed.
2. The drainage will need to be continued from the path that is already in place. She is organising a CCTV piping system to check what is in place and this will have to be replicated. It does seem to be a fairly simple system. 3. To do this, traffic lights will be needed and be funded by the Council. Ines will report findings as soon as possible. **Action Ines**
2. Resurfacing of Farrants was postponed but is still on the list to be done by contractors.
3. The Clerk asked for advice about training the Lengthsman to carry out spraying. Ines said there is now a new Enhancement fund and there is a new person running it. She may be able to help. The Clerk is to send an email to Ines with details and questions **Action Clerk**
4. Patching has taken place on Lea Lane.
5. Discussed land around phone box – the Clerk needs to send postcode of box. **Action Clerk**
6. Grit bins – Ines is still in the process of organising. She has had confirmation that the money from Cllr Keeling will be ringfenced for this. **Action Ines**
